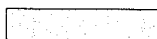

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

THIS MATTER COMES BEFORE THE BOARD on the request of the Director of Government Ethics that the formal investigation initiated against Respondent herein be dismissed; and

IT APPEARING that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code §1-1162.13(a)(2), a formal investigation was initiated against Respondent, based on a finding by the Office of the Inspector General of a violation of the Code of Conduct, in which it was alleged that Respondent misused government property and used his public office for private gain; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that insufficient evidence exists to support a reasonable belief that a violation has occurred; it is, therefore

ORDERED that the formal investigation initiated against Respondent be, and hereby is, DISMISSED.

This Order is effective upon approval by the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability, as demonstrated by the signatures below.


