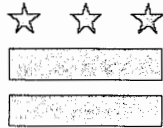

ORDER

THIS MATTER comes on upon the request of the Director of Government Ethics that the Notice of Violation against Respondent be dismissed, and the entire record herein; and

IT APPEARING that a Notice of Violation was issued against Respondent on September 7, 2017, alleging that he violated the Code of Conduct by failing to file Confidential Financial Disclosure Statements (CFDS) for 2016 and 2017; that Respondent was served the Notice of Violation on September 8, 2017; that Respondent subsequently filed a CFDS for each of the years in question and reached a negotiated disposition with the Office of Government Ethics rendering a full and adversarial hearing on this matter unnecessary; it is, therefore

ORDERED that the Notice of Violation issued against Respondent herein be, and hereby is, DISMISSED; and it is further

ORDERED that this case be, and hereby is, CLOSED.
