Beginning in 2015, NABP will offer the examination solely in a computer-based format. Traditionally, the PCOA has been offered in both a paper-based and computer-based format. The increase in the number of schools electing to use the computer-based format has resulted in a reevaluation of the program with regard to administration formats.	
	In an effort to standardize the administrations of the PCOA, NABP has elected to eliminate the paper-based format. The computer-based format allows NABP to immediately retrieve data after an examination and to evaluate the time that examinees spend on test questions.
