Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Dodson and properly seconded by Commissioner Smith, the Commission unanimously voted to require that Ms. Kelly complete the three mandated continuing education courses (DC Fair Housing-3 hours, DC Legislative Update-3 hours, and Financial Issues Update -3 hours) before reinstatement.

Mr. Ed Krauze, CEO, DCAR, appeared before the Commission on behalf of the District of Columbia Association of Realtors. Mr. Krauze indicated that the Association has always worked well with the Commission in its support and wishes to maintain the Association's efforts in

A. Mr. Hamilton Kuralt and Ms. Cecelia Arce presented consumer protection information to the Commission regarding the Property Information Verification System (PIVS) at DCRA. Mr. Kuralt informed the Commission that PIVS is available to the general public, which he stated, allows the general public to review the inspection history of a given property, thereby alerting the consumer if the property has had problems in the past, as well as providing access to the permitting record. Also, Mr. Kuralt stated that the PIVS will alert the consumer if, for example, a deck was installed on the respective property and if a permit was issued. He added that PIVS will assist the consumer in avoiding disastrous situations that may occur if the consumer is not knowledgeable of the public record involving a property. Chairman Duncanson and the Commissioners expressed appreciation to Mr. Kuralt and Ms. Arce for their attendance and delivery of valuable information. Mr. Kuralt will be meeting with various realtor and realtist organizations to further communicate the PIVS and its purpose.
