This case came before the Board for an evidentiary hearing on January 11, 2024, and, based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained in the accompanying Final Decision and upon the entire record in this case,

IT APPEARING that Respondent violated Counts 3-35 of the Amended Notice of Violation; it is, therefore

ORDERED that Respondent pay a civil penalty in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) each for Counts 3-35, for a total of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$165,000); and it is further

ORDERED that this matter be referred to the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia to consider whether additional enforcement or prosecution is warranted; it is further

ORDERED that Counts 1, 2, and 36-39 of the Amended Notice of Violation be, and thereby is, DISMISSED; and it is further

ORDERED that this case be CLOSED.
