**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

THIS MATTER COMES BEFORE THE BOARD on the request of the Director of Government Ethics that the formal investigation initiated against Respondent herein be dismissed; and

IT APPEARING that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1162.13(a)(1), a formal investigation was initiated against Respondent, based on a written complaint, in which it was alleged that Respondent, a lower court judge in the State of Mississippi, committed perjury in a proceeding she conducted in the Hancock County (Mississippi) Youth Court; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that, even if the allegation proved to be true, the Board has no jurisdiction over government employees in other jurisdictions; it is, therefore

ORDERED that the formal investigation initiated against Respondent be, and hereby is, DISMISSED.
