## FINAL ORDER

This case came before the Board for an evidentiary hearing on March 6, 2025, and based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained in the accompanying Final Decision and upon the entire record in this case,

IT APPEARING that Respondent violated Counts 1, 2, 4, 5, 8, 11, 12, 17, 19, 24, 25, 28, 33, and 34 of the Amended Notice of Violations, it is, therefore

ORDERED that Respondent pay a civil penalty in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for Count 1 and one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for each of Counts 2, 4, 5, 8, 11, 12, 17, 19, 24, 25, 28, 33, and 34 for a total of twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000); and it is further

ORDERED that this matter be referred to the Attorney General for the District of Columbia to consider whether additional enforcement or prosecution is warranted; it is further

ORDERED that Counts 3, 6, 7, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 29, 30, 31, 32, 35, 36, and 37 of the Amended Notice of Violation be, and thereby is, DISMISSED; and it is further
