

## BOARD OF ETHICS AND GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

The Board of Ethics and Government Accountability (“Board”), pursuant to the authority set forth in section 209 of the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Establishment and Comprehensive Ethics Reform Amendment Act of 2011 (“Ethics Act”), effective April 27, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-124; D.C. Official Code § 1-1162.09) (2013 Supp.), hereby gives notice of intent to adopt proposed rulemaking to amend Chapter 57 (Financial Disclosures and Honoraria) of Title 3 (Elections and Ethics) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (“DCMR”).

The rulemaking will amend section 5704.4 to bring it into conformity with section 225(a-1) of the Ethics Act, which section was added by the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Establishment and Comprehensive Ethics Reform Temporary Amendment Act of 2013, effective December 13, 2013 (D.C. Law 20-57; 60 DCR 15168).

The Board authorized the promulgation of this rulemaking on April 3, 2014.

Final rulemaking action shall be taken in not less than thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this notice in the *D.C. Register*.

#### **Chapter 57 of Title 3 of the DCMR is amended as follows:**

Section 5704.4 is amended to read as follows:

5704.4        Advisory Neighborhood Commissioners in office for at least thirty (30) days shall file a certification required by section 224(a)(1)(G) of the Act for the preceding year.

- (a)        The certification shall be due May 15<sup>th</sup> of each year;
- (b)        The certification shall be filed with the Ethics Board; and
- (c)        The certification shall be publicly filed.
